With Horizon Europe - the 9th Framework Programme for Research and Innovation - the European Union is providing funding totalling approximately 95.5 billion euros for the period from 2021 to 2027.

With the help of various calls for proposals, Horizon Europe supports the entire innovation chain from basic research to the first market launch.

The participation of publicly funded universities, associated institutes, state research institutions and vocational academies of the Free State of Saxony is sought in all funding areas.



ZEUSS EU-Service Saxony is an initiative of the Saxon State Ministry for Science, Culture and Tourism.

The services offered by ZEUSS aim to enhance the participation of Saxon research institutions as well as to increase the success rate of submitted project proposals in the European research framework programme Horizon Europe.

In principle, ZEUSS offers advice and support from the evaluation of initial ideas to the final report of the EU project.
