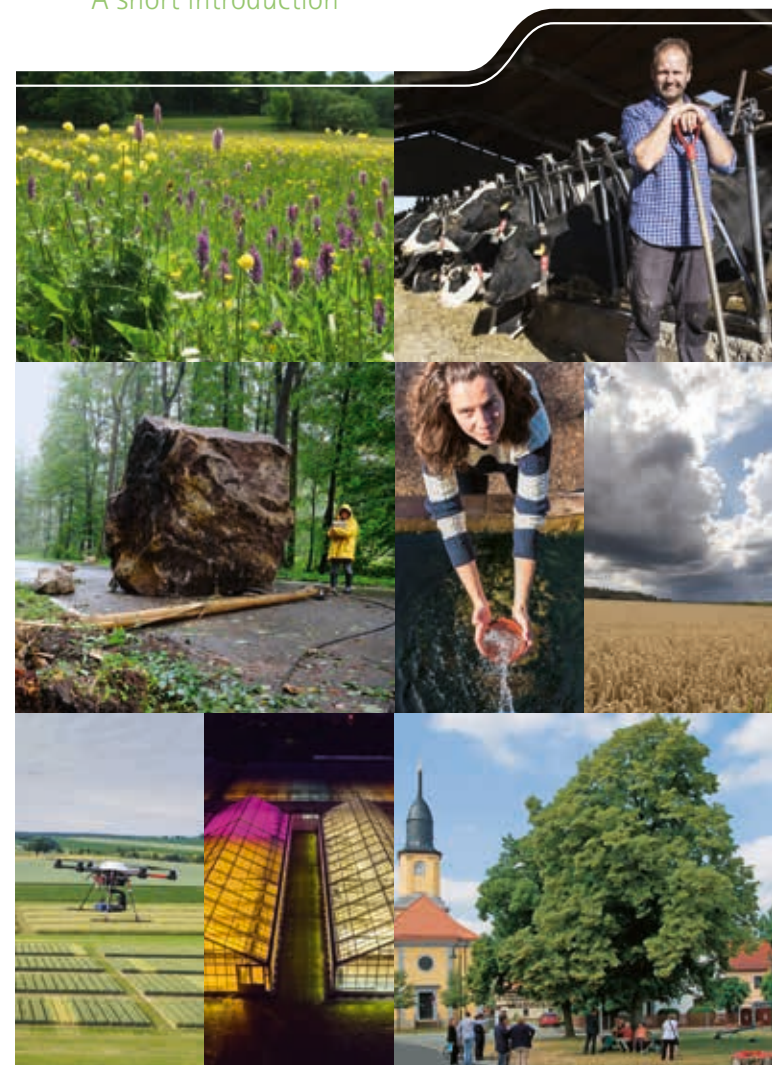

Saxon State Office for Environment, Agriculture and Geology (LfULG)

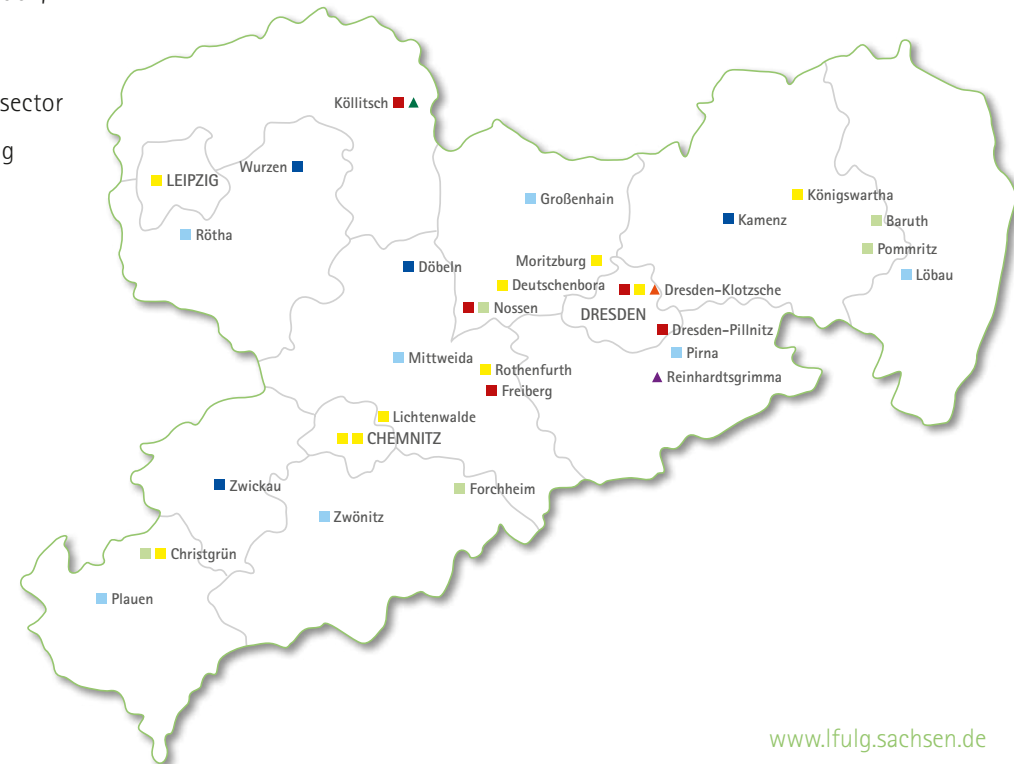
