The mining state of Saxony is home to a **valuable treasure** – it consists of geological and scientific data relating to raw materials, reports and information on the regional subsurface.

This treasure trove of data is now available **online and for free** for you on various portals.

From 2013 to 2024, the project "Rohstoffdaten Sachsen" (ROHSA 3), or Saxon Raw Material Data, collected data on Saxon ore and spar raw materials from all relevant archives throughout Germany. The core tasks of the project were the digitisation and public provision of the extensive information.

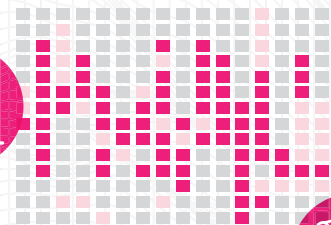
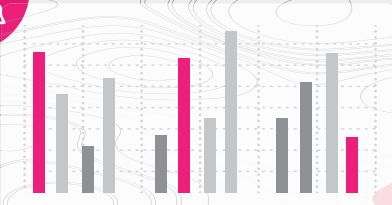

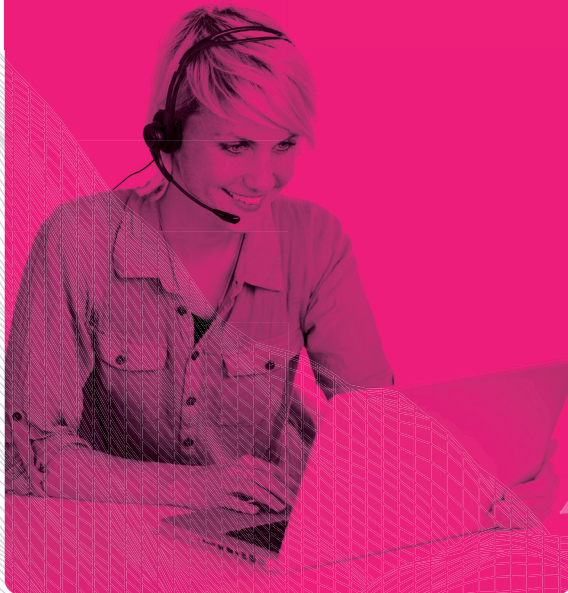

DiGA.Sax



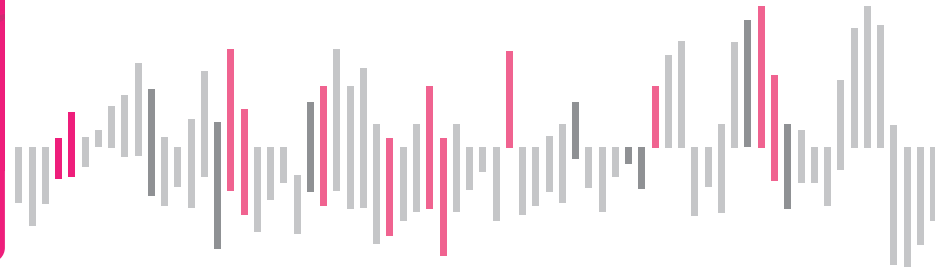
DiGA.Sax is the digital geological archive of Saxony. Just like in a reading room, you can gain direct insight into the digitised documents and maps on Saxon geology.

Functions such as downloads and OCR searches within the texts simplify and speed up your search.

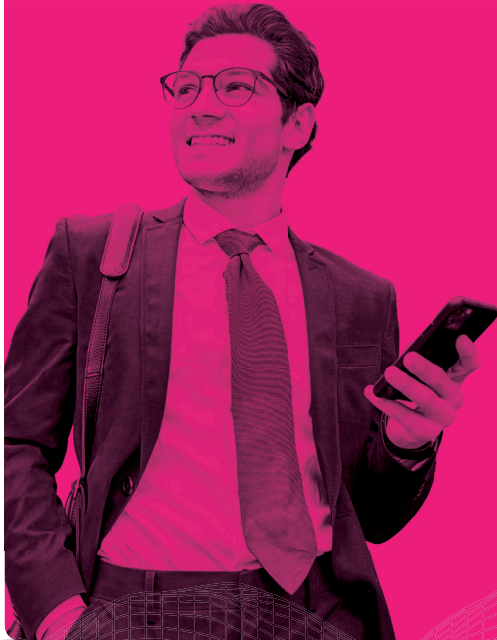
Documents with access restrictions can be requested for use online in the portal.

The iDA application provides access to environmental data such as the drillings and geochemical data of the Free State of Saxony.

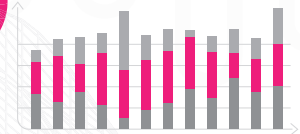
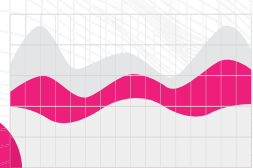

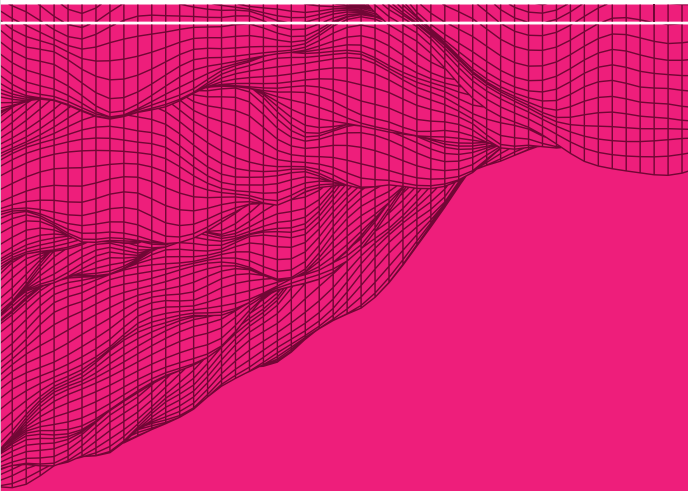
GeoMIS
